**POTENTIAL TRAFFIC IMPACTS RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION OF NEW I-75 SOUTH METRO EXPRESS LANES**  
**(WEATHER PERMITTING)**

- **UPCOMING DAYTIME WORK:**

Trucks will enter/ leave the roadway during daytime hours for the next three weeks (through end of November). Crews will perform clearing and grubbing of some trees along the corridor.

- **UPCOMING OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES:**

Overnight lane closures in place once through next weekend (11/23) so crews can place protective barrier walls.

I-75 northbound between State Route 138/Stockbridge Highway and State Route 155/McDonough Road	To occur every night between the dates of Monday, November 17 <sup>th</sup> – Friday, November 21 <sup>st</sup> between the off peak hours of 9 p.m. – 5 a.m.

- **UPCOMING OFF-PEAK LANE CLOSURES:**

I-75 northbound and southbound between State Route 138/Stockbridge Highway and State Route 155/McDonough Road	Beginning Thursday, November 17 <sup>th</sup> – Friday, November 21 <sup>st</sup> potential traffic pacing by State Troopers for controlled blasting work during off-peak hours of 11 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.

**Advisory:** Motorists are advised to slow down and proceed with caution through the work area; workers and heavy equipment will be in close proximity to the roadway.
