

Highway 42 Congestion Relief Project - \$3,500,000

Project Description



The Highway 42 Congestion Relief Project is a series of improvements coming from a joint study between the Georgia Department of Transportation and the City of Locust Grove to address the growing gridlock along SR 42 between Colvin Drive and MLK, Jr. Boulevard. First is to address at least two (2) crossing points either OVER or UNDER the railroad to fully connect each side of the City, especially during critical moments of fire and EMS. Next will be a series of strategies that consist of the following:

- Parallel Roadway/1-Way Pair Sections
- Improved Intersections at Market Place, Bill Gardner, Peeksville, and MLK, Jr. Blvd.
- Additional lanes on SR 42 to handle peak traffic, especially between Bill Gardner and Colvin
- Additional connections in the network to allow more traffic to use alternative routes
- Traffic Signal, Turning Lane, and Access Control measures where possible
