Sanitation:

Sanitation service (garbage) will be billed as \$16.00 monthly. Additional cans for service is available at \$11.50/can. For basic service, residents will be provided one standard-sized container that is picked up by an automated collection arm on the Waste Management Vehicle.

You may put only household garbage in the container and must be bagged. Containers must be placed at curb for pickup and must be removed from curb within 24 hours after pickup.

Items NOT allowed in containers: hot ashes, tires, batteries, paint, pesticides, yard trimmings, flammable items, construction debris, concrete, dirt, appliances and furniture.

Collection Site:

Collection point for larger items is located at 104 Mose Brown Drive next to Public Works and is open Wednesdays and Saturdays between 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. There is a \$20.00 fee (cash only) per pickup load, and you must use a current utility bill as proof of residency since this site is for city residents ONLY

Late fees of 10% will be added on the 16th and any bill not paid by the 19th will be DISCONNECTED ON THE 20th. In order to have service restored you must pay your balance due in full plus a \$50.00 fee.

Leaves/Chipping:

The City offers no-charge for collection of leaves and small shrubbery trimmings. These items must be bagged and placed beside the curb. Limbs needing to be chipped should be cut into lengths of three feet or less. The limbs are to be placed curbside for pickup on a weekly route schedule. Call for more information.

Bulk Pickup:

Items for bulk pickup is limited to four (4) items per week left curbside on a call -in basis to City Hall (770) 957-5043. Items typical for pickup include boxes, furniture, mattresses and used recreation equipment.
